

Physician Referral X-ray Information Form

MEDICAL IMAGING:

- All adult patients require x-rays in order for the referral to be triaged correctly.
- All lower Extremity x-rays should be ordered as **WEIGHT BEARING** if the patient is able.

MEDICAL IMAGING CHART: PREFERRED XRAY VIEWS

UPPER EXTERMITTY	VIEWS
Finger X-rays	AP, Lateral, Oblique
Hand X-rays	PA, Lateral, Oblique
Wrist (trauma) X-rays	PA, Lateral
Wrist X-rays	PA, Lateral, Oblique, Ulnar Deviation Grip
Scaphoid X-rays	PA 25 deg and 45 deg in ulnar deviation, Oblique, Lateral
Forearm X-rays	AP, Lateral
Elbow X-rays	AP, Lateral
Humerus X-rays	AP, Lateral
Clavicle X-rays	AP, 15 deg Cephalad
Shoulder	True AP, Axillary, Outlet and AC Joint
Shoulder Instability	True AP in ER and IR, West Point, Stryker Notch
Shoulder Arthroscopy	True AP, Axillary, Lateral
LOWER EXTERMITTY	VIEWS
Pelvis X-rays	AP, Inlet, Outlet
Hip X-rays	AP Pelvis, Lateral
Hip X-rays	AP Pelvis, AP, Lateral (True lateral not frog leg)
Femur X-rays	AP, Lateral
Knee Series	Full Leg Standing, 20/20 (PA Flexion Views) Skyline, Lateral, Bilateral Knees
Knee X-rays	AP (Standing), Lateral, Skyline, Notch
Knee X-rays (trauma)	AP, Lateral
Tibia/Fibula X-rays	AP, Lateral
Ankle X-rays	AP, Lateral, Mortise (standing)
Ankle X-rays	AP, Lateral, Mortise
Calcaneus X-rays	AP, Lateral, Harris
Foot X-rays	AP, Lateral, Oblique (Standing)
Foot X-rays	AP, Lateral, Oblique
